

QUAKERTOWN CHRISTIAN SCHOOL Home School Policy

Rationale - Quakertown Christian School realizes areas where we can contribute to home schooling programs in our community. In order to support parents who made this choice of education for their children, we have developed this policy.

Local school districts are responsible to establish, monitor and regulate these programs. We can assist families who are already in an approved home schooling program.

How QCS Can Service Home Schoolers

1. **Participation in Standardized Testing** when administered at the appropriate grade level.
2. **Instructional Materials** – QCS will make instructional material available as the school supplies permit and/or will assist family in the purchase of needed materials.
3. **Regularly Scheduled Classes** – Home schooled students may participate in music, art, physical education, conversational Spanish, library instruction, instrumental and strings instruction, computer literacy and band as there is room in the classroom and for those registered in the program. Upper school (Gr. 6-8) academic subjects – Spanish 1, English, Literature, Social Studies, Science, Pre-Algebra, Algebra and Math would also be available, if space.
4. **After School Sports** – Boys' Soccer, Girl's Field Hockey, Girls' and Boys' Basketball, and Track/Field and Girls' Soccer will be offered for students in Gr. 5 – 12 (as there is space).
5. **Chapels, Special Assemblies** – Home schoolers would be welcome to attend Chapels and Special Assemblies if enrolled for a regularly scheduled class at QCS.
6. **Library Use** – The QCS Library facilities may be used on a regular basis under the Librarian's supervision when a class is not in session. Books and videos may be borrowed.

Admission Procedure

For all Home School Students –

Parent completes the Application for Admission and pays the \$40 family registration fee yearly.

For Home School Students enrolling in one or more academic courses -

Parent meets with the Principal and provides student records for the principal to review.
